Supplement discription

A shiny, black coat and a beautiful, full mane and tail are characteristic of the Friesian horse, as are the long socks on the legs. Friesian Expert Powder contains elements in high concentrations to optimally support the Friesian horse. Biotin, but also methionine, zinc, copper and sulfur play an important role in the condition of the coat and the quality of the hooves.

Sulfur

Sulfur-containing amino acids, such as methionine and cysteine, are also important building blocks for the body. They stimulate the build-up of keratin. The concentration of sulfur in the body is highest in the hooves and fur, which contain keratin. Sulfur provides a flexible connection between the cells in the hoof horn and is necessary for the repair and construction of hoof wall cells. Methionine is an amino acid that cannot be produced by the horse's body itself and must therefore be supplied through its diet. That is why Friesian Expert Powder contains methionine.

Zinc

Zinc supports a beautiful, shiny coat and plays a role in the regulation of skin functions and the construction of the skin structure. Copper plays a role in the pigmentation of the hair and supports the connective tissue. Connective tissue is found throughout the body and also in the skin. Connective tissue is important for the firmness and flexibility of the skin.

Biotin

Biotin is a well-known B vitamin that contributes to a healthy skin condition and strengthens the hooves. Horses can produce biotin themselves, B vitamins are released through fermentation of roughage in the gut and can be absorbed by the body. However, with many grains, a less fiber-rich ration or a lower quality roughage, less fermentation takes place and less biotin is produced in the gut. Additional addition of biotin may then be necessary. For the best effect of the extra addition of biotin, it is recommended to feed this for a longer period of time (at least 6 months).

Intestinal flora

When the intestinal flora is out of balance, this can affect the condition of skin, coat and hooves. This is because too few B vitamins can be produced in the intestines and the absorption of nutrients is not sufficient. That is why Friesian Expert Powder contains yeast and various B vitamins to keep the intestinal flora healthy and to promote the absorption of minerals and vitamins. In short, Friesian Expert Powder contains important elements to support your Friesian with a shiny, black coat and beautiful, full mane and tail.
